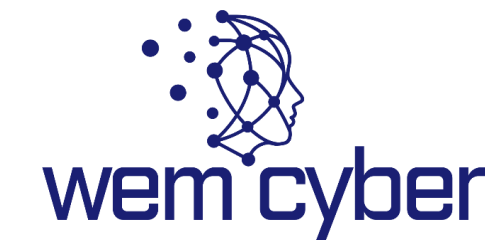

- Our mission is to connect organisations across Europe **to strengthen skills development and collaboration between academia and industry**, particularly in Widening countries.

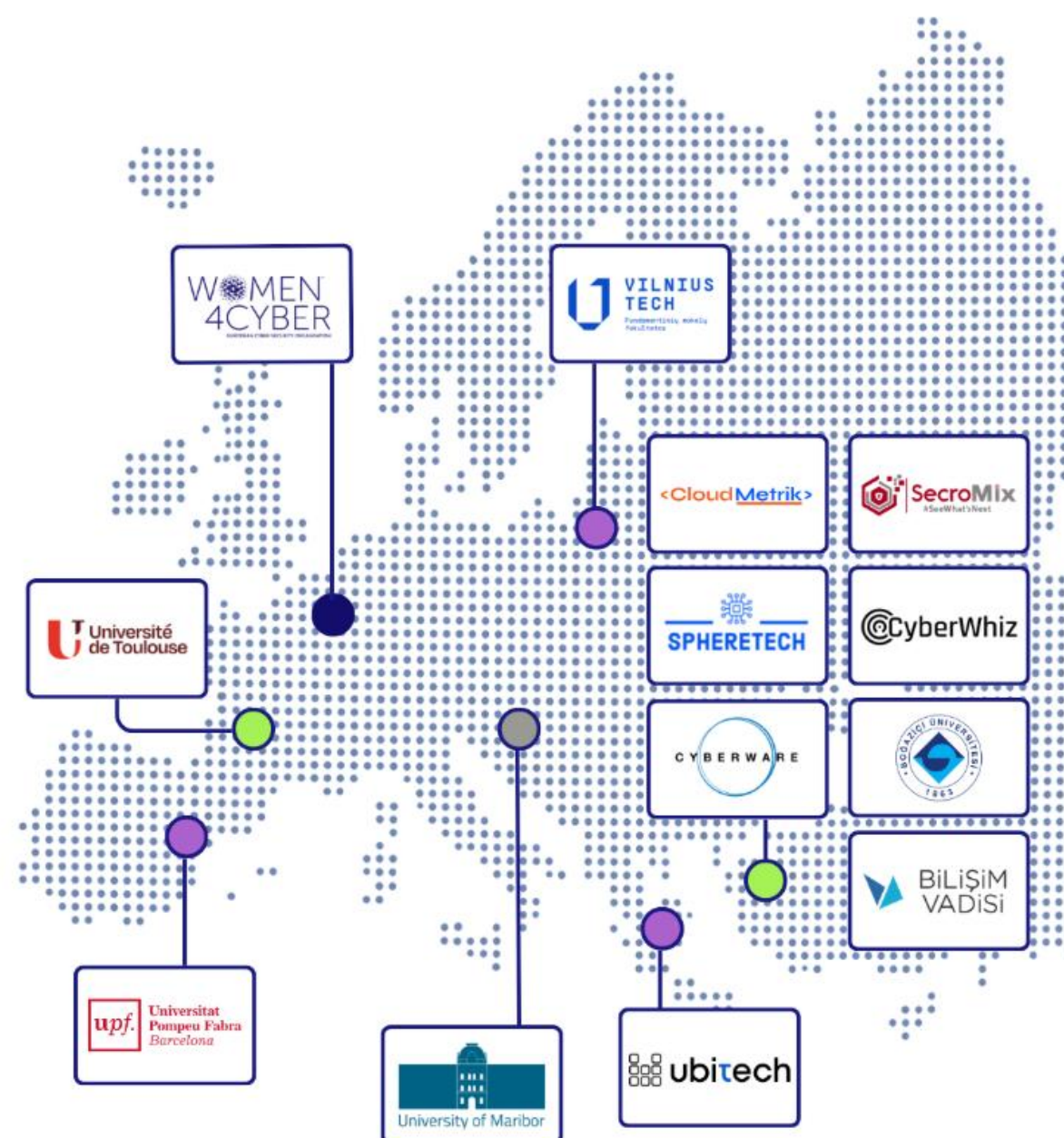

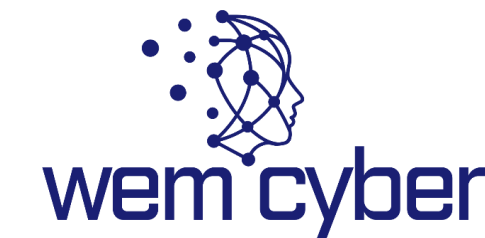
